
**ORDER COMPELLING
DISCOVERY PURSUANT TO
RULE 4:23-1 and 4:23-2 AND
DENYING PLAINTIFF'S REQUEST
FOR A PROTECTIVE ORDER**

THIS MATTER having come before the Court by Susan Sharko, Esquire, of Drinker, Biddle & Reath, LLP, attorneys for Defendants, Daiichi Sankyo, Inc., Daiichi Sankyo U.S. Holdings, Inc., Forest Laboratories, Inc., Forest Pharmaceuticals, Inc. and Forest Research Institute, Inc. (hereinafter "Defendants"); and in the presence of Rayna Kessler, Esquire, of Robins, Kaplan, LLP, attorney for the Plaintiffs, for the entry of an Order pursuant to Rules 4:23-1 and 4:23-2 compelling the production of all documents obtained by Plaintiffs through a FOIA request to the FDA; and the Cross-Motion of Plaintiffs for a Protective Order; and the court having considered the submissions of the parties, and oral argument of counsel; and for the reasons stated in the court's Memorandum of Decision of even date herewith;

IT IS on this 12th day of MAY, 2015, **ORDERED** as follows:

1. The Defendants' Motion to compel discovery is hereby GRANTED.
2. Plaintiffs' Cross-Motion for a Protective Order is DENIED.

3. Within fifteen (15) business days of the entry of this Order, Plaintiffs shall produce all records obtained by Plaintiffs through their November 6, 2013, FOIA request to the FDA.
4. This Order shall be read together with the companion Order of even date herewith. Said Order addresses the remaining outstanding written discovery, separate and apart from the production of the FDA public records ordered herein.
5. A true copy of this Order shall be served upon all counsel of record within seven (7) days of service of this Order.
