STANDING ORDER

BROWN, Chief Judge

In a letter dated May 26, 2011, David Voreacos, Jason Grant, Peter Sampson, David Porter, and Samantha Henry (hereinafter collectively the “Journalists”), accredited journalists who have offices in the Martin Luther King Courthouse in Newark, petitioned the undersigned regarding their ability to utilize lap-top computers in courtrooms for the purpose of documenting proceedings in the Newark courthouse. Having considered the matter;

IT IS THIS 3rd day of June, 2011, hereby

ORDERED that until further order of the undersigned, the foregoing Journalists are exempted from the general provisions of Local Civil Rule 501.1 pursuant to the terms of L. Civ. R. 501.(f)(3), and may therefore utilize lap-top computers in courtrooms throughout this District, as necessary, for the purpose of reporting proceedings, subject to further order to the contrary by the presiding United States District or Magistrate Judge on a particular case;

ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall forward a copy of this standing order to the Chief Deputy United States Marshal, as well as all United States District and Magistrate Judges for this District.
