The average number of matters he has litigated, over the past 5 years, was 10/yr., of these, most were civil and were in the Superior Court of New Jersey in various counties throughout the State. All of these cases, save 10, were jury trials.

He has also been involved in several criminal trials and appeals before the US 3rd Circuit Court of Appeals as well as having handled both criminal and civil matters in various Federal District Courts while currently being an Arbitrator for the US District Court for the Northern District of New Jersey.

Of the cases with which I have been associated, during this time period, the most note worthy cases would be the State of New Jersey v. Margaret Kelly Michaels, and the interstate child custody battle which is contained in record of Schuyler v. Ashcraft, 293 N.J. Super. 201 (App. Div. 1996), cert. den. _ N.J. _ (1997) I have been associated with this case as Mrs. Ashcraft's counsel since 1993 in the capacity as trial and appellate counsel. The Supreme Court has denied Certification. This matter involves not only the State Uniform Child Custody Jurisdiction Act and the Federal Parental Kidnapping Prevention Act, but also allegations of child sexual abuse, domestic violence, kidnapping, extradition, writs of habeas corpus and State and Federal Due Process.

During the time period from 1982 to 1990, the bulk of my cases were criminal in nature. As a direct result thereof, I spent most of my working hours in Court. The most note worthy of the cases during this time period was State of New Jersey v. Margaret Kelly Michaels. While I was associated with this case since 12/85, from 1/87 to 4/88, I spent 100% of my time in Court handling motions, jury selection and actual trial! During this time period, I was chief trial counsel. In spite of the fact that Ms. Michaels was convicted of 105 counts of child abuse, the Appellate Division reversed the conviction, 264 N.J. Super. 579 (1993) and the Supreme Court sustained said reversal.

By way of example of the number of trials with which I was involved, during the time period between 10/86 and 12/86, I handled 16 criminal trials.
