The Court having held a status conference call with the parties on November 30, 2016; and this Order intending to confirm the Court's rulings; and for good cause shown,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED this 1st day of December, 2016, as follows:

1. To the extent any plaintiff requests to file an amended complaint or amended short form complaint, a copy of the proposed amended pleading shall first be served on defense counsel. Thereafter, the parties shall meet and confer in-person or by phone to determine if defendants will consent to the amendment. If consent is given, the moving party shall prepare a Consent Order to be sent to the Court. To the extent consent is not given, plaintiff shall file a Motion to Amend. The motion shall be filed in the individual case and the master docket. Defendants shall respond to the Motion to Amend within seven (7)

days of service. No reply shall be filed. After defendants' response is filed, plaintiff is responsible for listing the motion on the agenda for the next scheduled conference call or conference.

- 2. To the extent any amended short form complaint has been filed without leave of Court, the amendment is STRICKEN. If an amendment is sought the moving party shall follow the procedure in paragraph 1 herein.
- 3. To the extent not already done, defendants shall respond to the following motions by December 10, 2016:
 - a. "Motion to Substitute Party to Name Administrator as Plaintiff" [Doc. No. 4]. Love v. Daiichi Sankyo, Inc. et al. (16-3446 (RBK/JS)).
 - b. "Motion to Amend/Correct Short Form Complaint" [Doc.
 No. 3]. Keys v. Daiichi Sankyo, Inc. et al. (16-4205
 (RBK/JS)).

The motions shall be put on the agenda for the next scheduled conference call or conference.
