Previously served in all trial court divisions including as Presiding Judge of the Chancery Division, General Equity and Probate Parts, handling complex commercial and corporate matters, restrictive covenants, minority shareholder litigation and claims for injunctive relief, among others. Authored over 150 published opinions in many areas of law, including torts, employment, product liability, criminal, administrative and constitutional law.

As Executive Assistant Attorney General, supervised all civil law and regulatory matters within the New Jersey Department of Law and Public Safety, an agency of more than 10,000 employees, directly overseeing the Divisions of Law, Gaming Enforcement, Civil Rights, Consumer Affairs, Motor Vehicles, Alcoholic Beverage Control and Racing. In the absence or disqualification of the Attorney General, served as Acting Attorney General.

As Director of the N.J. Division of Gaming Enforcement, managed the work of 544 personnel assigned to the state regulatory agency that polices and oversees legalized casino gaming in Atlantic City, and whose duties include the investigation of all individual and corporate applicants for casino and casino-related licenses, the review and auditing of casino operations, and the investigation and prosecution of all casino-related crime. Directed all legal affairs of the Division, including litigation, rule making, statutory revision, formulation of investigative guidelines for review of complex corporate financial transactions and criteria to measure fiscal stability and integrity.

Alternative Dispute Resolution Experience As a general equity judge in the Chancery Division, from 1996-2000, presided over bench trials, adjudicating cases involving commercial contracts, restrictive covenants, corporate dissolutions, minority shareholder oppression claims, business and construction disputes, easements, will contests, injunctive and other forms of equitable relief.
