

STANDING ORDER 12 - 2

Upon the Court's own motion, due to the emergency aftermath of Hurricane Sandy throughout the District of New Jersey, the Court declares the inaccessibility of all Clerk's Offices for purposes of Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 6(a)(3) and Federal Rule of Criminal Procedure 45(a)(3) from October 29, 2012 through and including November 5, 2012, unless further extended by Court Order due to exigent circumstances. Thus, if the last day for filing under Civil Rule 6(a)(1), or under Criminal Rule 45(a)(1), falls on any date through November 5, 2012, the time for filing is extended to the first accessible day that is not a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday. Election Day, Tuesday, November 6, 2012, is a legal holiday by Court Order. The next accessible day may be November 7, 2012, or such later date if extended by further Order.

The foregoing is SO ORDERED this 1st day of November, 2012.
