O R D E R

The Court having held a discovery conference with the parties on December 16, 2015; and this Order intending to address certain issues raised by the parties in their Status Report and Proposed Joint Agenda [Doc. No. 200]; and good cause existing to enter this Order; and accordingly,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED this 21st day of December, 2015, as follows:

1. The parties shall meet for a discovery conference on **Wednesday, January 13, 2016 at 9:00 A.M.** in Courtroom 3C of the Mitchell H. Cohen United States Courthouse, 1 John F. Gerry Plaza, Camden, N.J. 08101. The issues to be discussed include but are not limited to: whether all Defendant Fact Sheets should be served via e-mail on plaintiffs' counsel and plaintiffs' liaison counsel, and whether this requirement should be

retroactive; defendants' application to remove four custodians from the Japanese custodian list; and whether defendants have complied with paragraph 1 of the Court's October 30, 2015 Order [Doc. No. 181]. All letter submissions in connection with the January 13, 2016 Discovery Conference shall be served by January 11, 2016.

2. By December 31, 2015 plaintiffs shall produce their list of the 20 Daiichi U.S. employees or ex-employees they request to depose, listed in the order plaintiffs would like the deponents' documents produced.

3. By January 8, 2016 defendants shall provide their best estimate of when they will complete their document and ESI production for the individuals identified in plaintiffs' October 22, 2015 and November 5, 2015 letters, and plaintiffs' forthcoming December 31, 2015 deposition list.

4. As per the Court's previous oral order, by today, December 21, 2015, the parties shall serve the Consent Order memorializing the Japanese Custodians to be searched as set forth in paragraph 2 of the Court's October 30, 2015 Order [Doc. No. 181].

5. By January 19, 2015, defendants shall produce in electronic format all presently available electronic information available in the United States concerning the Road Map Clinical

Trial and Trial Master Files referred to in paragraph 1 of the Court's October 30, 2015 Order [Doc. No. 181].
