It is on this *10th* day of November, 2016, ORDERED that the Local Civil Rules are amended to read:


Civ. RULE 101.1 ADMISSION OF ATTORNEYS

(c) Appearance Pro Hac Vice; Local Counsel

(5) A lawyer admitted pro hac vice is within the disciplinary jurisdiction of this Court. A lawyer admitted pro hac vice may not withdraw as counsel without leave of this Court before the action is terminated.

It is FURTHER ORDERED these amendments are effective this date.
