**AMENDED NOTICE TO THE BAR
OCTOBER 9, 2025**

NEW PROCEDURES RELEVANT TO CRIMINAL INFORMATIONS

Notice is hereby given to the Bar and all interested parties that, effective October 1, 2025, new procedures regarding Criminal Informations shall be implemented.

Upon receipt of a letter requesting an Information be assigned, the Clerk's Office will assign a criminal case number and open the "shell" of the case, adding only the names of the parties and counsel. The request will be docketed as: "Letter Requesting Information Case Assignment." Neither the Information nor plea-related documents will be docketed in the matter until after the initial appearance and plea hearing have been held.

Initial appearance and plea hearing dates and times will be set only via the docket, and all parties and counsel should consult the docket for this information. Moreover, all parties and counsel should communicate with the Court through the docket.
