THESE MATTERS having come before the Court in response to the parties' submissions pursuant to this Court's Order of May 22, 2015;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiffs shall respond to Defendants' objections to Plaintiffs' proposed Master Complaint articulated in their letter dated May 29, 2015 (Doc. No. 28) within seven (7) days of the date of this Order. The Court shall enter an Order addressing the filing of the Master Complaint and the Short Form Complaint after considering Plaintiffs' response.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Defendants' request to include paragraph 14 and paragraph 17 in Plaintiffs' proposed Short Form Complaint is **DENIED**.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiffs shall include a paragraph alleging the citizenship of each party in the Short Form Complaint.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Defendants' objection to Plaintiffs' version of paragraph 18 of the proposed Discovery Protective Order is **SUSTAINED**. The parties shall resubmit to the Court the proposed Discovery Protective Order including only Defendants' version of paragraph 18.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the parties may not file any dispositive	
motions without leave of this Court.
