The United States District Court for the District of New Jersey announces that all paper filings are to be placed in the Drop Box in all courthouses in the District. If you are making a payment using a check and/or money order, it should be placed in a <u>sealed envelope, labeled with</u> name, docket number (if available) and return address.

The Centers for Disease Control has advised people to take precautions in light of the COVID-19 virus outbreak and noted that the best way to prevent illness is to avoid being exposed to this virus. Therefore, effective immediately the Clerk's Office will only be accepting filings and payments through the Drop Box.

• Credit Card payments may be made on Thursdays <u>ONLY</u> , by calling the Finance Office at (609) 989-0468.
