Pursuant to the Judicial Administration and Technical Amendments Act of 2008, the Jury Selection and Service Act, 28 U.S.C. Subsection 1861, et seq., the Fees, Subsection 1871(b)(2), has been amended to reduce the amount of time after which a petit juror may receive a supplemental daily fee by striking "thirty days" and inserting "10 days" effective October 1, 2009.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

Petit jurors hearing one case will receive the supplemental fee, not exceeding \$10 more than the attendance fee, for each day of service in excess of ten days required to hear the case.

Grand jurors serving in excess of forty-five days will receive the supplemental fee, not exceeding \$10 more than the attendance fee. If the attendance fee is increased in the future,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT:

Petit jurors serving more than ten days in one case and grand jurors serving more than forty-five days shall receive the increased amount without issuing a new standing order.
