## LOCAL CIVIL RULE 101.1, ADMISSION OF ATTORNEYS

(c) Appearance *Pro Hac Vice*; Local Counsel

. . . .

(2) The order of the Court granting a motion to appear *pro hac vice* shall require the out-of-state attorney to make a payment to the New Jersey Lawyers' Fund for Client Protection as provided by New Jersey Court Rule 1:28-2(a). This payment shall be made for any year in which the admitted attorney continues to represent a client in a matter pending in the Court. A copy of the order shall be forwarded by the Clerk to the Treasurer of the Fund.
