### **Mediator/Arbitrator - ADR Options, Inc.**

1995 to Present

- Judge Naythons successfully mediated the first Clean Water Act litigation in the United States by resolving the Pennsylvania litigation. Thereafter, he resolved the Delaware litigation.
- He has mediated/arbitrated over 1,200 cases in such areas as: Contracts, employment discrimination, product liability, professional liability and personal injury.

### **United States Magistrate Judge - Eastern District of Pennsylvania**

1971-1995

- Judge Naythons' specialty was complex litigation. His precedent setting opinions clarified many complex discovery disputes stemming from the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure.
- He mediated and settled many cases in the areas of product liability, casualty, negligence, employment, intellectual property and antitrust.

### **United States Attorney - Department of Justice, Eastern District of Pennsylvania**

1970-1971

- Judge Naythons was the attorney in charge of Medicare fraud prosecutions, and was a prosecutor in many drug and major felony crimes.
- He defended high profile tort claims filed under the Federal Tort Claims Act against the federal government.

### **Special Assistant to the Attorney General - Commonwealth of Pennsylvania**

1963-1965

- Judge Naythons was responsible for reforms to the Philadelphia County legal system after investigating corruption in the system.
