
STANDING ORDER 17-2

In all cases in which an interpreter is used to the extent necessary to communicate with their client, counsel appointed under the Criminal Justice Act, 18 U.S.C. § 3006A, are hereby authorized to utilize interpreter services up to \$2,500 without obtaining preauthorization from the assigned judge.

Interpreter services in excess of \$2,500 shall require preauthorization from the assigned judge, which will be subject to review and approval from the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit.
