**WHEREAS**, on July 23, 1984, the Court entered a Standing Order regarding the referral of all cases under Title 11 of the United States Code to the U.S. Bankruptcy Judges of this District (the “1984 Standing Order”); and

**WHEREAS**, on September 18, 2012, the Court entered Standing Order 12-1, which amended and supplemented the 1984 Standing Order, affording the U.S. Bankruptcy Judges of this District the authority to submit proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law in proceedings referred under Title 11; and

**WHEREAS**, by entry of a June 2, 2025 Order, this Court amended Local Civil Rule 301.1 to delineate that U.S. Bankruptcy Judges of this District may serve as a mediator or settlement judge as part of his or her official judicial duties; and


**WHEREAS**, given the newly amended Local Civil Rule 301.1, as well as the 1984 Standing Order and Standing Order 12-1, this Court deems it necessary and appropriate to update its procedures and protocol for referral of cases and proceedings to the U.S. Bankruptcy Judges of this District; accordingly

**IT IS ORDERED**, effective immediately, that as related to the referral of cases and proceedings to the U.S. Bankruptcy Judges of this District, any such Judge is authorized to act as a mediator or settlement judge as part of his or her official duties; and it is further

**ORDERED** that, to the extent necessary or appropriate to give effect to this aspect of the reference, all U.S. Bankruptcy Judges of this District are designated as judicial neutrals under 28 U.S.C. §§ 651-57, and thus entitled to all the legal immunities and protections afforded to such individuals; and it is further

**ORDERED** that this Standing Order supplements the 1984 Standing Order and Standing Order 12-1; and it is further

**ORDERED** that all provisions of the 1984 Standing Order and Standing Order 12-1 that are not within the scope of this Standing Order remain in full force and effect.
