A lawyer admitted *pro hac vice* shall complete all the requirements set forth in L.Civ.R. 101.1; namely, (1) a Court order granting a motion to appear *pro hac vice* shall be entered in the particular case, and (2) the Admission Fee must be paid to the Clerk of the Court for attorneys admitted *pro hac vice* after March 22, 2005.

**NOTE:** This application permits receipt of electronic notification only. According to L.Civ.R. 101.1, only local counsel are entitled to sign and file papers, enter appearances, and receive payments on judgments, decrees or orders.
